

COMPETITION BRIEF

Double-base whole body sculpture of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman to represent his 7th March Speech of 1971. The sculpture will take place at the historic Sharawardy Udayn, Dhaka, where Father of the Nation delivered his monumental address on 7th March, 1971. Sculpture will be built in such a way, that it will represent the actual scenario what took place on 7th March, 1971.

DESCRIPTION OF THE SCULPTURE

- Height of the main sculpture will be 19 feet 6 inches
- Length and width of the main sculpture will be 6 feet 9 inches and 6 feet respectively or as appropriate.
- Base of the sculpture will be 2 feet 6 inches in height
- Podium height will be 14 feet, its length and width will be 8 feet and 3 feet 6 inches respectively.
- Sculpture including its base need to be in bronze, thickness of both sculpture and its base cannot less than 1 (one) inch.
- Combination of bronze may be: 80% Copper, 15% Tin & 5% Zinc or as appropriate combination of International standard.
- A color photograph has been attached in the tender document to represent the sculpture.

REQUIREMENTS OF THE PARTICIPANTS

The participants (sculptors) need to submit the dummy model that needs to comply the following characteristics:

- The height of the dummy model which will participate in the competition will be 4 ft 4 inches
- Model will be made of fiber
- Dummy model needs to be placed in a sealed container measuring 6 feet by 4 feet or as required.



Alongside these, participants need to submit the following documents:

- Detail specification of the model materials
- Total weight of the sculpture and Longevity of the sculpture
- Maintenance procedure of the sculpture
- Detail costing of the sculpture (that includes material cost, sculptor remuneration, labor cost, contractors profit including VAT and other related cost)

BACKGROUND OF THE PROJECT

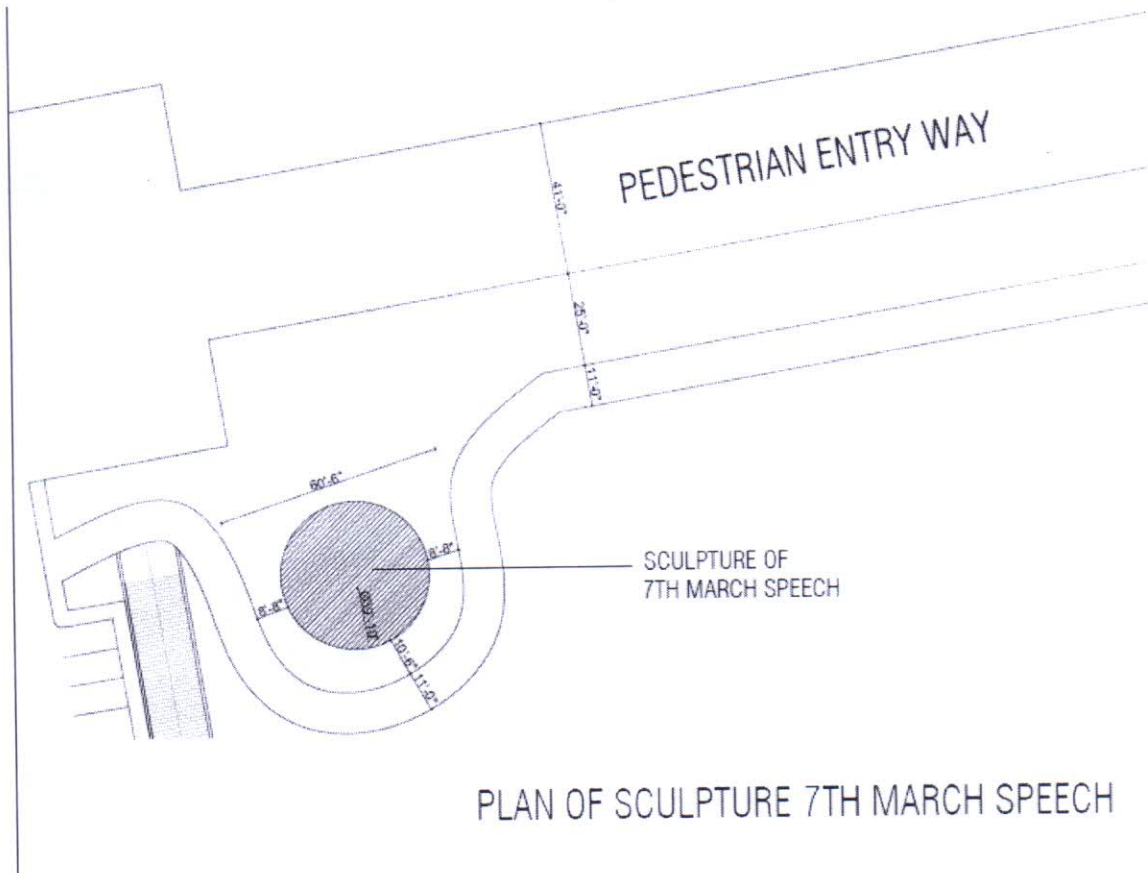

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Deviations from the documents to be submitted as asked for in the following will lead to the jury excluding the design and proposal from assessment.

LANGUAGE

All competition submittals are to be provided in English or Bangla.

ANONYMITY

During the competition, the anonymity of the entrants must be ensured. All submittals are to have 6 ft X 4 ft or as required cartoon firmly sealed that contain the dummy model. A sealed envelope containing the DECLARATION FORM should accompany the submittals. The envelope must be marked with blank square box only. Revealing the identity of any entrant during competition period will lead to the disqualification of the design and proposal.

The Client will not insure submitted materials. Entrants are expected to make backup copies of their dummy model and proposals.

OWNERSHIP

The Client retains ownership of the submitted documents up to publication of competition result. The entrants will be notified by email when and where these will be returned.

PUBLISHING AND EXHIBITING

The Client has the right to freely publish competition designs and proposals. Designs and proposals may be exhibited and published during the competition period while maintaining anonymity for the entrants.

APPROVAL OF THE COMPETITION BRIEF

The competition brief and appendices will be approved by The Jury Board, selected by MOLWA. They will short list 3 (three) models and the final one will be chosen by the competent authority. By submitting a design and proposal to the competition, the entrants accept the competition's brief, rules and regulations.

DISQUALIFICATION

An entry or entrant will be disqualified if

- They do not comply with the Eligibility Requirements.
- They do not comply with the Entry Requirements.
- Incomplete and wrong Declaration form.
- The entry is received after the lodgment deadline.
- The entrant improperly attempts to influence the decision of the Jury.



- The entrant has communicated directly with any member of the Jury/ employee involved in the competition/ or any coordinator for the purposes of the competition.
- Any name, sign or symbol on drawings, model or any submittal that helps to trace the participant will disqualify the entry.
- Any resemblance to design which jurors find it partly a copy from another project.
- Any person related to the competition process such as jurors, committee members, organizers or competition director or their personal firms or their subordinate firms cannot participate in this competition.

LEGAL AND REGULATORY PRINCIPLES

Entry in this competition implies agreement by the Organizer (MOLWA), the Jury and the candidates to abide by the terms of the competition regulations, specifications and program, and the replies given to Entrants' queries.

Submission of an entry constitutes acceptance of the decisions of the Jury and the decision of MOLWA, which shall be final.

The Commissioning Organization undertakes to follow an impartial procedure for the selection of candidates. No appeal shall be admitted.

By participating in the competition, candidates confirm their acceptance of these regulations, specifications, and program, and affirm that they are acquainted with and will strictly abide by the Timetable for the successive stages.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Sculptor [s] winning the First Prize shall be formally appointed by the First Party on the basis of the Public Procurement Act 2006, Public Procurement Rules 2008 (especially Rule 111), for the comprehensive non-consultancy services including Architectural, Structural, Electrical and Mechanical design services with supervision and construction of Sculpture based on pre declared cost (with negotiation rate, if required) as per the Standard Agreement and Scale of Professional Fees which is mentioned below and will be on the competition brief. If the first prize winner cannot be appointed for any valid reason under the "Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct" or the Competition Regulations to such appointment. In such case, the Second Prize winner shall be invited. If this winner cannot be appointed for valid reasons, the Third Prize winner shall be invited. The appointed Sculptor shall have to make any reasonable modification to his/her design in accordance with the recommendations of Jury.

Pre declared Cost will be below:

The fees for Architectural, Structural, Electrical and Mechanical Design Consultancy services including Material cost of the proposed bronze sculpture will be considered including Contractors Profit, VAT and other all related cost.



The provisional construction cost of Sculpture will be as per recent market rate which will be subject to award of construction contract.

- The appointed Sculptor shall have to make any reasonable modification to his / her design in accordance with the recommendations of Jury.
- If, for any unavoidable reason, the First Party wants to cancel the competition after the entries are received, the entries shall have to be evaluated and the prize shall have to be awarded. First Party shall return all the submitted designs to the respective Sculptors. None of the submitted designs can be executed by the First Party or any other Sculptor appointed by the First Party. The First Party shall place an advertisement in the newspapers informing the cancellation of the competition and the newspapers shall be the ones that initially carried the advertisement announcing the competition. In such cases First Party must pay the first winner 3 times of the prize money.
- The copyright and authorship of the designs will remain with the respective Sculptor.
- First Party may form an advisory committee to guide and advice on the project implementation progress and qualities. First Party may include Second Party's nominated member in the committee.
- No member of the Jurors, the Competition Director and his team, the Competition Manager, their family members or their business associates/Partners or employees are eligible to compete or assist competitors in any way in the competition.
- Members of the Jurors shall not involve themselves in any way with the Project after the competition, except where PWD and MOLWA jointly make a request in writing for such any involvement.

VALIDITY PERIOD OF TENDER

The Tender shall remain valid for **120 (one hundred and twenty) days** after the date of Tender opening.

COMPLETION TIME OF WORK

The Intended Completion Date for the whole works shall be **12 (twelve) months** reckoned from the date of commencement of work (start date).

PROPRIETY

Competitors (or any representative of a competitor) must not at any time before the Jury makes final announcement of a winner, contact, or interview or attempt to interview or to discuss or to attempt to discuss with Jury members, employees, Competition coordinator and authorized representatives, any matter about the competition or any other entrant submitted in response to this competition. The jury reserves the right to reject any entry lodged by a competitor which contravenes this condition.



PUBLICITY DURING THE COMPETITION PERIOD

Once the jury's decision on the designs and proposals has been finalized, the competition result will be made available. During competition period the competing Consulting Firms are expected not to give interviews, make comments, or in any other way make public their own or others' entries until the competition result is disclosed.

COPYRIGHT

Entrants retain copyright to their entries but will give MOLWA a perpetual, royalty-free license to use their entries for the following:

Informing and consulting the community through an exhibition. Documenting the competitive process for internal reporting, public notification; and Inclusion on MOLWA website or in any publication prepared by the MOLWA on the competition process and outcomes.
